Employment increased by 12,200 (6%).

Participation rate



At 63.8%, the West region had the third lowest labour force participation rate when compared to all other regions, observing an increase of 1.5 percentage points between q3 2019 and q3 2021.

Agriculture

Employment increased for both females and males; however the increase observed for females (7,600 persons or an 8% increase) was almost double when compared to the increase observed for males (4,600 persons or a 4 % increase).

Agriculture saw the largest absolute increase in employment (5,200 persons or a 43% increase) with total employment in quarter 3 2021 at 17,200.

In November 2021, there were 4,357 people in receipt of a Pandemic Unemployment Payment in the West region representing 1.9% of persons in the labour force (based on Q3 2021).
