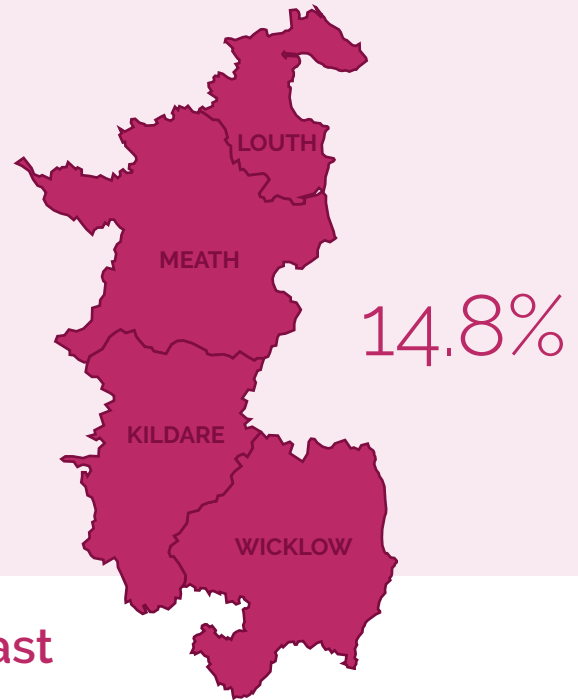


## Employment

The Mid-East accounts for **14.8%** of employment in Ireland (338,800 persons)

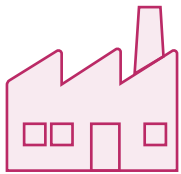
Top 5 Sectors	Total employed	Q1-Q3 2020
Industry	45,900	+15% ▲
Wholesale & retail	44,800	-9% ▼
Health	42,100	+7% ▲
Education	31,800	+3% ▲
Construction	25,900	+2% ▲



## Impact of COVID-19 on the Mid-East

(from Q1 2020 to Q3 2020)

### Employment



↓ **0.5%**  
Employment fell by **1,700 persons (0.5%)**



Females experienced a fall in employment of 2,300 persons (1.5%); the number of males in employment remained almost unchanged (increase of 0.3%)

### Work Force



↑ **63.7%**  
The labour force participation rate increased from 62.6% in Q1 to **63.7%** in Q3

### Wholesale & Retail Sector



The wholesale & retail sector saw the largest absolute decline in employment (**4,200 persons or a 9% decrease**) whereas employment in industry increased by 5,900 persons

Numbers unemployed Q3 2020

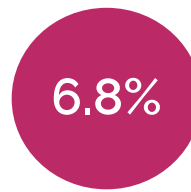


Change from Q1-Q3 2020 UE Number

## Region rates – Overall comments



Mid-East region has a **lower UE rate than the national average**

Mid-East observed the **third highest increase** in their UE rate between Q1 2020 – Q3 2020 behind Dublin and West region

## Pandemic Unemployment Payments - Week 44

Persons receiving Pandemic Unemployment Payment in the **Mid-East** region:

- **46,900 persons**, compared to 87,700 in May 2020 (Week 18)
- Accounting for **13.8% of the labour force\*** in the region (14.4% overall in the State)
- 26.4% (or 12,400 persons) **aged under 25 years** (25.3% for the State)
- **51.1% female** (50.4% for the State)
