


Profile of Part-Time Workers in Ireland









Impact of COVID-19 on persons working part-time

Between quarter 1 and quarter 2 2020:

77,600 - decline in those employed part-time	
31 % - decline for 15-24 year olds working part time	11 % - decline for those aged 25 years and older working part time (40,000 persons)
43,000 – decline for those working part-time due to school, education or training	28,000 – decline for those looking after children, adults or for other personal or family reasons
Sector – decline of 45,000 for those in wholesale & retail sector combined with the accommodation & food sector	Occupation – decline of 44,000 in part-time employment in service and sales occupations
