

The labour force participation rate decreased from 62.9% in Q1 to **61.6% in Q3**  Industry

The fall in employment was greatest for females, at 6,200 persons (or 3.9%), compared to 4,000 persons (or 2.2%) for males.




Industry saw the largest absolute decline in employment (3,600 persons or a **6% decrease**)

## Pandemic Unemployment Payments - Week 44

Persons receiving Pandemic Unemployment Payment in the South West region:

- 46,000 persons, compared to 84,600 in May 2020 (Week 18)
- Accounting for 13.8% of the labour force\* in the region (14.4% overall in the State)
- 27.2% (or 12,500 persons) aged under 25 years (25.3% for the State)
- 53.9% female (50.4% for the State)
- \* based on Quarter 3 2020
