
FET Learner Outcomes: Post-Leaving Certificate (PLC)

One of the three strategic priorities in the **FET Strategy 2020 – 2024** is '**Pathways**'. The goal is for FET to offer clear pathways into FET, within FET, and from FET, enabling smart choices at all stages of people's lives and careers.

FET Graduate Outcomes



Sector Share of FET Graduates



29% of graduates work in wholesale and retail



19% in accommodation and food service

13% in human health and social work activities (second largest employment sector)



The employment rate increased to **64%** in **2016** for the **2014/2015** PLC cohort.

Using the **educational longitudinal database (ELD)** we know that **54%** of PLC graduates (2012-2013) were in substantial employment in 2014, earning a weekly wage of €305.38, which increased to €431.50 in 2018.






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
FET Learner Outcomes: Post-Leaving Certificate (PLC)



PLC Pathways to Higher Education



27% PLC graduates were in higher education in 2014, with14% in higher education and substantial employment



Pathways in FET are not always in one direction. Between **2012-2014**, **12%** PLC learners were previously enrolled in a third level course.
